News from Norway Park for October 2024

Report from Erik-Bjarne Witzøe

As the first autumn leaves gently fall, the fading memories of Sankt Hans, picnics, swimming, and fishing still bring a smile of summer's experience. It's time to get your favorite Norsk sweater out of storage with the cooler evenings ahead, and before you know it, the December Julebord is here.

The Nødvendig (the red washroom building) lower park recently had an emergency with a sewage backup in August during a rental event. The cost, totaling \$4,100 to hire a plumber out of urgency, was able to get the system up and running after guests panicked. It's always a good reminder to be conscious about what is being flushed.

The Washington State Department of Fish & Wildlife (WSDFW) has notified LERA that the second phase of the culvert, the stream in the lower park, must be completed. Therefore, the LERA Board overwhelmingly approved the reinstatement of the Lower Park Stream Committee to work in tandem with the state. The committee will be spearheaded by Bjørn Lunde, who diligently worked on it over the past decade. A date for the second phase is imminent, and an update will be published.

The Berg Pavilion paint project is well underway. Colors are being mixed, and supplies are being purchased. The first batch is dipped by paint brushes and rollers, which soak up paint in trays. We are still looking for volunteers with flexible scheduling. Contact Madeline at jasne@comcast.net. The project will continue until October.

REMINDER: Boat Storage: Any boats that have been on the ground most of the winter should be removed. Norway Park is a recreation association so we should allow small boats by the boat dock area during the summer. The caretaker is asked to weed-trim around the boats, but is not expected to move them in order to mow. Any boat left at the beach should be marked with lot# of the owner. Boats can be stored down the trail at the end of campground as long as they are stuffed in the brush and at your own risk, the only issue is they are out of site and could easily be stolen since out of sight. Any boats left at the beach after Labor Day weekend will be donated to the Lake McMurray Fire Department for their fundraising of the building repair and new fire truck. BIBLIOTEK

The library at the lodge accepts many Norwegian/Scandinavianoriented book donations from generous and thoughtful members. We receive quite a lot of books by the contemporary Norwegian author, Jo Nesbø! As you know Nesbø is the master of the Norsk Krim genre, and is the best-selling Norwegian author of all time. His works have been translated into over fifty languages and have sold millions worldwide. The books are page turners with interesting characters and unique plot twists interspersed with the right amount of action and comedy, such as the famous Harry Hole detective series. Many of his books have been made into movies including The Snowman 2017, Headhunters 2011, Occupied 2015, The Hanging Sun 2022, Exit 2019, Jackpot 2011. However, Nesbø himself claims that his favorite genre is **HORROR** and as a child he was always telling ghost stories to his friends. Since it is the **Halloween** season a good book to settle into late at night would be one of his only true horror books published just last year called "THE NIGHT HOUSE", which is also available to listen to on audible.com!




