A Dog's Devotion

Adventures of the Search & Rescue K9 Team with Suzanne Elshutt, MA & Guy Mansfield, PH.D

Social 5:30 PM, Dinner 6:00 PM, Program 6:45 PM. Meeting 7:00PM

Suzanne Elshult and Guy Mansfield are authors of the book *A Dog's Devotion* featuring "Keb," who, recently passed away at 14 ½ years. Keb was one of the dogs who were sent to the Oso land slide to help rescue or to locate bodies. "Kili" follows Keb and is certified as a human remains detection dog. You will get to meet Kili at the membership meeting. Suzanne has been deployed on hundreds of missions since 2001. She has held leadership positions with both the Snohomish Search & Rescue K9 Team, Everett Mountain Rescue and the Canine Forensic Foundation and with the Mason County Search & Rescue. She and her K9 partners have been working on missions ranging from disasters to urban searches looking for individuals diagnosed with dementia, missing children, mountain and wilderness searches along with searches for old ancestral graves, especially those of Indigenous children who were forcibly taken and placed in boarding schools.

Guy Mansfield, has been active in search and rescue since 2008 with the Everett Mountain Rescue, Snohomish County Volunteer Search and Rescue and Cascadia Search Dogs. He has deployed Search and Rescue missions ranging from wilderness searches to rope rescues. Guy has also been involved in some of the most extensive searches in NW Washington. He has assisted law enforcement in searches for human remains and is the founder and director of the Washington State Search and Rescue Planning Unit. Guy has a Ph. D from the Department of Behavioral Neuroscience at Oregon Health Science University and has done research at various universities.
