Sports Medals: I often get asked about sports besides walking, swimming, bicycling and skiing. For other sports, points are earned for every 10 minutes of an activity. For example, if you are in Leikarringen and you go to a 2 hour dance class every week for 4 weeks you will have earned 288 points. If you are 60 years old, you would be almost a third of the way to the 1050 points needed for a Bronze medal. Walking is measured in miles. If this same 60-year-old goes for a 5 mile walk 3 times a week for 120 miles at the end of the month the Bronze medal (105 miles would be earned, and 15 miles towards the Silver medal (210 miles). Here are some other sports (there are more listed on the cards) and points per 10 minutes. If your sport is not here, let me know and I'll determine how many points per 10 minutes. Golf: 5 points per 10min; Kayaking: 12 points per 10min; Soccer: 15 points per 10 min. More information on Sports Medals is available at SOFN.com.

#### **IN MEMORIUM**

Georg Mikal Kjonsvik passed away on January 6, 2023, at age 91. Born in Strinda, Norway to Gustav and Parsoini Marie Kjonsvik, Georg had two brothers, Odd and Harry. A couple of his uncles had emigrated to the US in previous years, so Georg followed suit, moving to the US in 1955 to pursue a new life in Seattle. Georg maintained close family ties, both with his cousins John and Ron in the US, while cherishing weekly phone calls with his brother Harry and making many return trips to Norway over the years. Following a brief time in the Norwegian Air Force, Georg joined the US Army. He was stationed at Fort Ord, CA from June 1956 to June 1958, including 18 months of overseas duty in Germany. Georg joined the Lodge in 1973 and became a Golden Member in 2003 and received a 45-year pin in 2018. He was one of the original volunteers who built Leif Erikson Lodge. Georg was active until he became ill in January of this year. He was a great member of the Lodge and knew a lot of members.
